New Business:

Union County EMS involvement in the Union County Fair – Monte will check on board to use for Kid's Day, Tuesday, July 27, 2010.

The association would like to help promote highway safety laws. Mick will talk to Jan about a link on the website for periodic information.

Discussion on disbursement on the FY11 training grant – Total will be \$3871.00. Cheryl motioned to divide money equally between 4 departments at \$967.75 each, seconded by Monte, all in favor, motion passed.

Discussion on system to keep the MCI/Casualty equipment and supplies in ready condition. Mick proposed having a check off list of supplies, Wes suggested rotating 6 months before expiration date to the hospital. Cheryl will write up a policy for same.

Educational report:

Cheryl said that she could reapply for the (I Love Our Kids grant), Monte motioned for her to go ahead, seconded by Wes, all in favor, motion passed.

Cheryl attended an MCI class, which talked about a program with (Officer in a Bag). Example – triage officers bag has sheet with vest and instructions of what your job is, and would be the same for other levels.
